GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Membership Fees

Members are reminded that fees are payable in advance and are therefore due on or before 01 January each year.

2. Address of Members

Members shall notify the Secretary in writing immediately upon change of address, and telephone numbers. Members are requested to provide the Club with their email address if they have one.

3. Complaints

All complaints on any matter connected with the management or service of the Club or the conduct of any employee of the Club shall be made to the President, who may, if necessary, insist that such complaint be made in writing.

If the President is unable to satisfy the complainant or complainants, then he/she shall submit the matter to the Board for review and decision.

4. Members and Visitors

All members and visitors to the playing course, practice area and general area are required upon arrival to lodge your name(s) and sign the PGC entry book located at the Pro Shop, including the reason for your visit i.e... Play golf, walking, practice etc.

5. Dress Standards

- The Board expects all members and guests of the Club to be suitably attired in clean apparel and footwear both on the course and in the clubhouse. (No Singlets within the clubhouse)
- No singlets , bare feet or work boots permitted on the course
- The Board reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone not conforming with the requirements as displayed at the entry to the Clubhouse

6. Course Etiquette

- No player shall play until the players in front are out of range. Any group failing to hold its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front shall allow the group following to pass.
- When the play of a hole is completed, players shall move to the next tee before marking their cards. The player with the honour shall play before marking their card.
- Players are responsible for repairing their own divot marks and bunker marks and are encouraged to repair others.
- No one shall move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.

<u>The lowest handicapped player in each group is responsible for the observance of the rules of golf and etiquette.</u> <u>This does not however, relieve all players of their responsibilities under the rules of golf.</u>

Slow play is contagious - help to eliminate it. PGC Supports and Encourages "Ready Golf"

7. LOCAL RULES

• The halfway house (between the 7th, 6th and 15th fairways) is an integral part of the course. A player may

take relief under the unplayable ball rule 19.2 under a one-shot penalty or play it as it lies. There is NO FREE RELIEF from the halfway house.

- The Double green (6th and 15th holes) if your ball comes to rest on the wrong green of the hole you are playing, then you MUST take nearest point of relief without penalty within one club length of the wrong green. (The separation of the greens is signified by a dotted line on the slope between the two greens).
- Red Penalty Areas -The red penalty areas on the 8th hole, beside the 12th green and behind the 4th green are in play. Lateral relief allows you to drop a ball into a relief area measured from where your ball last crossed the edge of red penalty area. From that reference point, you are allowed to drop outside the penalty area anywhere within two club-lengths of that spot, no nearer to the hole (see Rule 17.1d(3)).
- A. Out of bounds
- Defined by the course boundary fence, black and white stakes, paint on concrete, beyond any garden edge or where otherwise specified with signage. The player must take stroke-and-distance relief by adding one penalty stroke and playing the original ball or another ball from where the previous stroke was made.
- B. Ground Under Repair
 - All internal roads
 - Any bare patches within the course boundary that contain embedded rocks that could cause damage to yourself or your equipment, a player may take nearest point of relief no closer to the hole– Your marker must approve a free drop in this instance. Note: The large rocks on the right of the 5th fairway DO NOT constitute any free relief.
 - Clearly defined wheel ruts in the general area caused by course machinery
 - Any areas circled with white paint and or GUR signage
- C. Immovable Obstructions (rule 16)
 - All stakes defining GUR, OOB, Penalty areas and distance markers
 - Fixed sprinkler heads, pit and tap covers
 - o Sponsors signs / Tee signs / permanent seats
 - o Staked trees and shrubs -relief MUST be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1b
 - all posts, chains, ropes, drainage grates, mulch around trees, sand bins, sand bucket stands, garbage bins.
- D. Abnormal Course Conditions
 - Bare patches on the greens that have been caused by weed spray or dry areas (lie of ball only), lift and place to nearest point no nearer the hole.
 - Bare patches on the fairway of the hole you are playing, the player may take free relief at the nearest point not nearer to the hole.
 - Exposed tree roots on fairway being played.
 - Earth cracks due to dry conditions.
 - Any damage caused by an animal (kangaroos, cockatoos, etc.).
- E. Movable Obstructions
 - All white hoops, removable signs, chains, hazard pegs (NB: must be replaced)
- F. Preferred Lies
 - Will depend on the course conditions and will be sign posted at pro shop.
- G. Player Information Pins
 - RED Front area of the green WHITE middle area of the green BLUE Back area of the green
- H. Distance Markers
 - White posts on sides of fairway indicate 100metrs to centre of green, Blue posts indicate 150 meters to centre of green and Red posts indicate 200 meters to centre of green
- I Multi Tee Events
 - The PGC promotes the use of Multiple tee options for designated competition events Members can select from the Yellow, Red, White or Blue tee markers to play on that day. The players GA handicap will be adjusted dependant on the slope rating of each marker.
